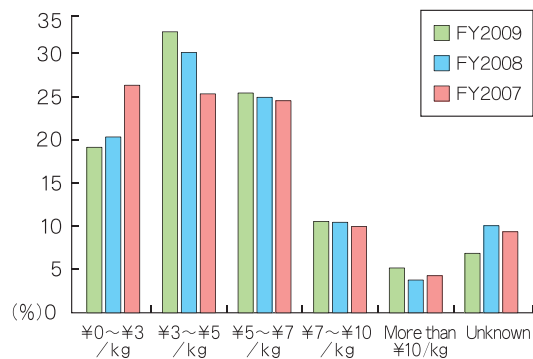


Grants to Practicing Groups for General Recyclables

In FY2007, the highest ratio is less than ¥3, but the ratio gradually decreases year by year. In FY2009, ¥3~¥5 is the highest ratio recording 32.6%. By regions, Kanto, Chugoku and Kyushu/Okinawa are relatively high recording average ¥6.

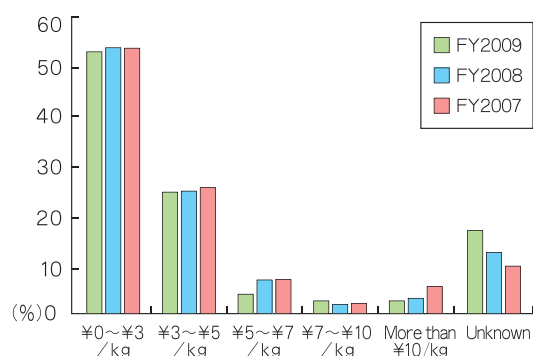

Subsidies to Collecting Companies for General Recyclables

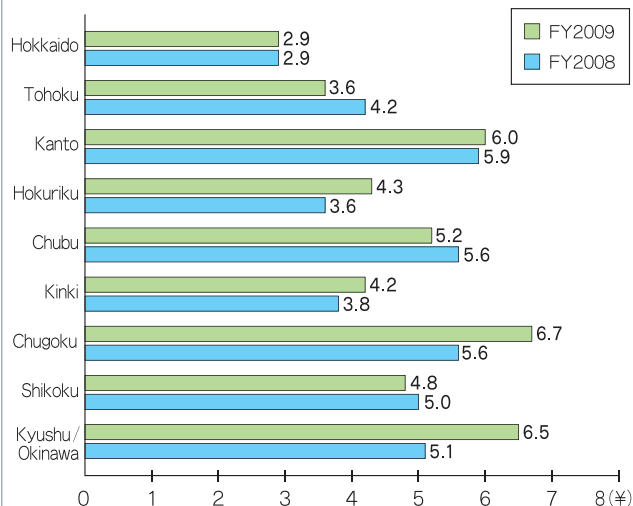
The distribution of the amount is the same as usual and less than ¥3 is more than half recording 51.3%. By region, the ratio in Hokkaido, Kanto and Chubu are high.

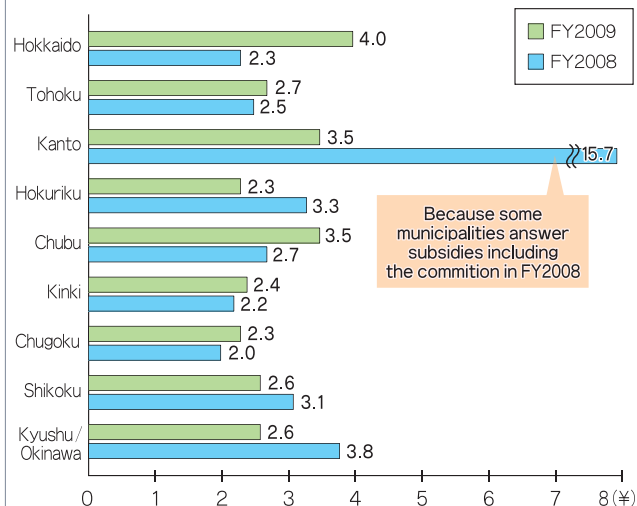

Grants for Steel Cans

The financial initiative for steel cans has increased slightly than the year before. Most of the subsidies is from ¥5 to ¥7 at the highest ratio recording 33.5%.
